6 WHEREAS, the Riverside County Board of Supervisors on July  
7 31, 1990, ordered the formation of a Regional Park and Open Space  
8 District within the County of Riverside (Resolution No. 90-396)  
9 subject to the confirmation of voters; and

10 WHEREAS, an election was held on the question of creation of  
11 the District on November 6, 1990; now, therefore,

12 BE IT FOUND AND DETERMINED, RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the  
13 Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of  
14 California in regular session assembled on December 11, 1990, that:

- 15 1. The total number of votes cast on the question of the  
16 Formation of the Riverside County Regional Park and Open  
17 Space District was 174,440 of which 106,857 were cast in  
18 favor of its formation and 67,583 were cast against its  
19 formation.
- 20 2. Resolution No. 90-396 of the Board of Supervisors of the  
21 County of Riverside ordering the Formation of the Riverside  
22 County Regional Park and Open Space District is confirmed.
- 23 3. The total number of votes cast on the question of allowing  
24 for an assessment was 171,351 of which 74,775 were cast in  
25 favor and 96,576 were cast against, thereby denying the  
26 ability to levy such assessment.
- 27 4. The territory to be included within the District shall
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include all unincorporated areas of the County of Riverside,  
lying west of a north-south line passing through Chiriaco  
Summit, and the incorporated municipalities of Calimesa,  
Canyon Lake, Cathedral City, Coachella, Desert Hot Springs,  
Indian Wells, Lake Elsinore, Murrieta, Palm Desert, Palm  
Springs, Rancho Mirage and Riverside.

5. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is authorized and  
directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution with  
the Secretary of State and cause to have a certified copy  
recorded with the County Recorder.

Subsequent to the adoption of Resolution 90-717, this department will recommend the organization of your Honorable Board as the ex officio Board of Directors of the district, establishment of rules of proceedings, the appointment of a general manager and other administrative officers, the adoption of required measures, ordinances and regulations, and other matters.


