Pursuant to Board Policy A-49 (Customer Satisfaction Performance Policy), please find the results of the customer satisfaction surveys collected at park sites, special events, interpretive sites, and park reservations for fiscal year 2022/2023.

During the reporting year, the District collected 2,066 customer satisfaction surveys from patrons of our Regional Park and Open-Space facilities. Of these surveys, 83% were completed by customers who utilized our online reservation system to book their campsite reservation. Guest were asked to rate their experiences in 5 categories: Cleanliness and Condition, Check-in Experience, Staff Helpfulness, Site Recommendation, and Reservation Process.
